Buckland Parish Council – 2023/24 : Transparency Reporting

As Buckland Parish Council has recorded less than $\pounds 25,000$ income and expenditure for the 2023/24 financial year total income it is required to comply with the Transparency Code for Smaller Authorities

In the 2022/23 financial year, a limited assurance review was undertaken and Buckland Parish Council opted to comply with the additional requirements of The Transparency Code in line with recommended best practice.

For reasons of consistency, Buckland Parish Council has decided to publish the same information for the 2023/24 financial year for consistency.

The Transparency Code requires local authorities in England with total income or expenditure exceeding £200,000 to publish the following information on a quarterly basis:

- Expenditure Exceeding £500 Council has chosen to publish a schedule that includes all ex-Vat payments exceeding £100 to maintain year to year consistency of reporting. The schedule for the full year is now available to download from the village website.

- Procurement Information As Buckland Parish Council does not have any legally enforceable agreements with a value exceeding £5,000 there is no information to publish.

- Local Authority Land As Buckland Parish Council does not hold legal title to any land or buildings and has not entered into any leases there is no information to publish

- Organisational Chart Buckland Parish Council has only one employee, the Clerk, who also serves as Council's Responsible Officer. Its organisational chart has only one point of contact and anyone wishing to engage with Council is asked to contact the Clerk.
- Trade Union Facility Time As Buckland Parish Council does not have any staff members who are union representatives there is no information to publish.

- Parking Account As Buckland Parish Council has no chargeable parking there is no information to publish.
- Parking Spaces As Buckland Parish Council does not have any controlled car park spaces there is no information to publish.
- Senior Salaries As Buckland Parish Council does not have any staff member whose salary is £50,000 or greater there is no information to publish.
